# Travel Plan

## Welcome

Welcome to the Crofthead Holiday Park travel plan. Here you will find how to get around the local area and to and from the holiday park without having to use a car.

The holiday park is located to the south of the A70 at Old Toll, approximately 3.5 kilometres to the east of Ayr town centre.

### Getting about on foot or bicycle

The main pedestrian routes to and from the Holiday Park are via the footway along the northwestern side of Sandyhill Terrace and along the northern side of the A70.

The footway along the northern side of the A70 is also a shared footway/ cycleway and provides a direct connection to and from Ayr Station and the town centre, mainly off road.

### On site cycle infrastructure

To further encourage cycling, a new lockable bike store for up to 20 cycles is in the process of being installed within the immediate vicinity of the reception.

### Travelling by bus

There is one bus service available to and from the Holiday Park via stops on the A70 at Old Toll.

There are buses during the day on Mondays to Saturdays to and from Ayr town centre via Holmston Road, as well as some areas outwith the town such as Coylton, Drongan, Ochiltree and Cumnock. Less frequent services operate on Sundays. Bus tickets can be bought from the bus driver or on-line and daily/ weekly/ monthly/ yearly tickets offer multi-journey opportunities at reduced costs.

Stagecoach West Scotland service 42 runs between Ayr and Cumnock via Coylton, Drongan, Ochiltree every 60 minutes (Monday to Saturday daytime), with short working between Ayr and Drongan every 60 minutes (providing a 30 minute headway over that section), every 120 minutes (Monday to Saturday evenings) and every 60 minutes (all day Sunday).

## Travelling by train

Ayr rail station is located in the town centre, some 3.5 kilometres to west of the holiday park.

Ayr rail station can be accessed via bicycle or via the Stagecoach West Scotland service 42. There is sheltered storage for 52 cycles available at Ayr rail station. Ayr rail station has a manned ticket office. There is also CCTV coverage, with ramps to both platforms.

Scotrail operates a 30 minute service between Ayr and Glasgow Central via Prestwick, Troon, Barassie, Irvine, Kilwinning, and Paisley. The journey time to Ayr is around 52 and 55 minutes.
